INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

MPT Hydro LP filed an application on March 24, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for an electricity generation licence.

MPT Hydro LP was previously licensed by the OEB, and its electricity generation licence EG-2001-0772 expired on January 21, 2022. In order to generate electricity for sale, the applicant requires an electricity generation licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act. Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out electricity generation activities, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order granting the electricity generation licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications. This licence is granted without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

An electricity generation licence is granted, on an interim basis, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence. The licence will be valid until November 4, 2022, or until the final determination of the electricity generation licence application, whichever is earlier.
