**Application for an Accounting Order to establish a sub-account of
the Capital Contribution Recovery Differential Account**

OVERVIEW

Hydro One Networks Inc (Hydro One) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on February 24, 2022, for an Accounting Order to establish a sub-account pertaining to the deferral of capital contributions payable to Hydro One by Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited.

The OEB granted the School Energy Coalition (SEC) and Power Workers' Union (PWU) intervenor status, and granted SEC cost award eligibility.

On April 13, 2022, Hydro One issued a letter advising of withdrawal of its application and on April 20, 2021, the OEB issued its Procedural Order No.2 in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received a cost claim from SEC. No objection to the cost claim was received from Hydro One.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed SEC's cost claim to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that SEC's cost claim is reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Hydro One.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Hydro One Networks Inc. shall immediately pay the School Energy Coalition \$1,091.58.
