## **POWIN ENERGY ONTARIO STORAGE II, LP**

## DECISION AND ORDER

Powin Energy Ontario Storage II, LP (PEOS) filed an application on March 29, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for an electricity storage licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

PEOS owns and operates an 8.8 MW battery storage facility located in Stratford, Ontario, which has been in commercial operation since 2018. PEOS intends to participate in the Independent Electricity System Operator's Operating Reserve, Reactive Support and Voltage Control, and Energy Capacity Markets using this storage facility.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to Powin Energy Ontario Storage II, LP.

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
