INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Plains Midstream Canada ULC filed an application on May 19, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 (1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

Plains Midstream Canada ULC electricity wholesaler licence EW-2017-0166 expires on June 7, 2022. In order for the applicant to continue its electricity wholesaler activities to consumers in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity wholesaler licence pursuant to section 57 (d) of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the licence EW-2017-0166, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of Plains Midstream Canada ULC electricity wholesaler licence EW-2017-0166 is extended on an interim basis until November 1, 2022, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. All other conditions of licence EW-2017-0166 remain unchanged.
