**Re: Reporting Requirements for Stations Upgrades for the East-West Tie Project  
Ontario Energy Board No.: EB-2017-0194**

On March 21, 2022, Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) filed its quarterly report on the progress of stations upgrades for the East-West Tie Project. The quarterly report provided details for the period ending February 28, 2022.

On March 31, 2022, the East-West Tie Project was placed in-service. It is expected that Hydro One will file a final quarterly report, in accordance with the requirements previously established by the OEB, for the period of March 1 to March 31, 2022. In addition, as part of its final quarterly report to be filed, Hydro One should include a table, using the same cost categories as all other quarterly reports, that sets out the final construction costs of stations upgrades for the East-West Tie Project. Hydro One should also provide detailed descriptions for any variances from the budget filed in the leave to construct application to actual costs incurred, including any additional costs incurred (e.g., costs due to the COVID-19 pandemic). The final report should be filed by June 21, 2022, but can be filed earlier if all necessary information is available.

In the unlikely event that Hydro One is unable to quantify certain costs when filing its final report, Hydro One should provide: (i) its best estimate of those costs along with, a

detailed explanation of how that estimate was calculated; and (ii) the date when Hydro One expects the final cost will be available.
