LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Cao:

Re: Imperial Oil Limited (Imperial Oil)

Application for leave to construct the Imperial Oil Pipeline Relocation Project Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2022-0171

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Imperial Oil's above-referenced application (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 through 3 below **prior to July 4, 2022**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at registrar@oeb.ca.

You are directed:

- 1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Imperial Oil's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of both the English and French versions of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
 - a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
 - b. Clerk of the City of Hamilton
 - c. Environment and Climate Change Canada (Environmental Protection Operations Ontario, Environmental Assessment Section)
 - d. Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency (Ontario Regional Office)

- e. Ministry Of Environment, Conservation And Parks (Air Pesticides And Environmental Planning Technical Support Section, West Central)
- f. Ministry of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade (Cabinet Office Liaison Unit, Policy Coordination Branch)
- g. Hamilton Conservation Authority
- h. Conservation Halton
- i. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline
- j. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Suite 1100 66 Slater Street, Ottawa, ON K1P 5H1
- k. all affected utilities and railway companies
- I. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To post a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, on Imperial Oil's website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.
- 5. To provide a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
