Independent Electricity System Operator – Intervention Request**

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) is in receipt of the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) Notice for this application and is writing to request intervenor status.

The IESO is responsible for maintaining and administering the Ontario wholesale electricity markets, and directing the operation and maintaining reliability of the IESO-controlled grid.
