**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. Ontario Energy Board File: EB-2022-0111
Bobcaygeon Community Expansion Project
Request for Adjournment and Response to Evidence Request**

We are legal counsel to Enbridge Gas Inc. ("Enbridge Gas") in the above referenced proceeding. This letter is in respect of (i) a request for an adjournment of the proceeding and (ii) correspondence of June 21, 2022 filed by Environmental Defence ("ED") regarding its request to file evidence in this proceeding.

Enbridge Gas respectfully requests a short adjournment of this proceeding until no later than October 31, 2022. Current economic and inflationary pressures continue to evolve. Given the current economic and inflationary environment, Enbridge Gas believes that updates to its market analysis and surveys must be completed to provide an appropriate basis for the customer attachment forecasts filed in support of the application. As Procedural Order No. 1 has not yet been issued, the adjournment has limited prejudice to intervenors.

With respect to ED's correspondence, ED wishes to file a report from Dr. Heather McDiarmid regarding the relative costs of heat pumps. At this time, Enbridge Gas takes no position as to the relevance of the proposed evidence. As Enbridge Gas does not have the specifics of the proposed evidence, Enbridge Gas reserves its right to object to the relevance of the proposed evidence until the content of the evidence is better understood. As a matter of procedural fairness, Enbridge Gas asks that if the OEB makes provision for the proposed evidence it also make provision for discovery related to the proposed evidence and for Enbridge Gas to file responding evidence, should Enbridge Gas elect to do so.
