On June 21, 2022, Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) filed its quarterly report on the progress of stations upgrades for the East-West Tie Project. The quarterly report provided details for the period ending March 31, 2022. In response to the Ontario Energy Board's letter, dated June 6, 2022, the quarterly report also outlined the construction costs for stations upgrades for the East-West Tie Project incurred up to March 31, 2022, and included descriptions for variances from the budget filed in the leave to construct application to actual costs incurred.
