



## **EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership**

## Application for natural gas distribution rates beginning January 1, 2023

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 August 12, 2022

EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (ENGLP) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 27, 2022 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) seeking approval for changes to the rates that ENGLP charges for natural gas distribution in its Aylmer service area, beginning January 1, 2023.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on July 14, 2022. No persons applied for intervenor status.

At this time the OEB is making provision for the filing of interrogatories and submissions. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. OEB staff shall request any relevant information and documentation from ENGLP that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on ENGLP by **August 23**, **2022**.
- 2. ENGLP shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories by **September 6, 2022**.
- 3. Any written submissions by OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and served on ENGLP by **September 20, 2022**.
- 4. Any reply submissions by ENGLP shall be filed with the OEB by **October 4**, **2022**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is

defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
