Re: The Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario (AMPCO) – Cost Claim Filing Extension

On August 10, 2022, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued its Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards in the above-mentioned consultation, which among other matters established an August 17, 2022 deadline for the filing of cost claims by cost-eligible intervenors.

On August 16, 2022, AMPCO filed a request with the OEB to submit its cost claim by August 26, 2022 due to its representative being unavailable to file on the 17th.

The OEB grants AMPCO's request. The OEB has accordingly revised the dates for the filing of cost claims and any objections as shown below:

- 1. AMPCO shall submit their cost claims by **August 26, 2022**. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served on each licensed electricity distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's Practice Direction on Cost Awards (Practice Direction).
- 2. Licensed electricity distributors will have until **September 2**, **2022** to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served on the eligible participant against whose claim the objection is being made.
- 3. The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until **September 9, 2022** to file its reply submission, if any, with the OEB, with a copy of the reply submission to be served on the objecting party.
