Re: The Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) – Cost Claim Filing Extension

On August 24, 2022, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued its Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards in the above-mentioned consultation, which among other matters established an August 31, 2022 deadline for the filing of cost claims by cost-eligible intervenors.

On August 31, 2022, BOMA filed a request with the OEB to submit its cost claim by September 9, 2022 to its representative being unavailable to file on the 31st.

The OEB grants BOMA's request. The OEB has accordingly revised the dates for the filing of cost claims and any objections as shown below:

1. BOMA shall submit their cost claims by **September 9, 2022**. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served on each licensed electricity distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's Practice Direction on Cost Awards (Practice Direction). Any cost claim filed after the original due date of August 31, 2022, must be filed with the OEB by email to registrar@oeb.ca and one copy is to be served on each licensed electricity distributor.
2. Licensed electricity distributors will have until **September 15, 2022** to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served on the eligible participant against whose claim the objection is being made.
3. The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until **September 16, 2022** to file its reply submission, if any, with the OEB, with a copy of the reply submission to be served on the objecting party.
