

**EB-2022-0157 – Panhandle Regional Expansion Project Leave to Construct
Pollution Probe Letter of Comment**

Dear Ms. Marconi:

In Procedural Order No. 1 for this proceeding, the OEB made provision for a technical conference given the significance and scale of the project and related issues. The proposed project is the largest in recent memory and has a significant number of issues and level of complexity¹. The value of a technical conference for this proceeding is extremely high and Pollution Probe recommends that the Technical Conference commence with a presentation by Enbridge to provide an overview of the Panhandle system, factors driving the proposed project and interaction with the broader system (with and without the project, including in-franchise and ex-franchise impacts). This approach was very helpful in a recent Technical Conference² and could decrease some time related to those issues.
