ALGONQUIN POWER (LONG SAULT) PARTNERSHIP AND N-R POWER PARTNERSHIP

Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Algonquin Power (Long Sault) Partnership and N-R Power Partnership filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 10, 2022, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Algonquin Power (Long Sault) Partnership and N-R Power Partnership owns and operates an 18 MW hydroelectric generation facility, known as Long Sault Rapids Generating Station, located in Cochrane, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Algonquin Power (Long Sault) Partnership and N-R Power Partnership.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
