DECISION AND ORDER

On August 16, 2022, Potentia Solar 12 Limited Partnership (PS12) filed a complete application with the OEB under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence renewal to retail to large volume consumers only.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

PS12 is wholly owned by Potentia Renewables Inc. (PRI, formerly known as Potentia Solar Inc.) and will develop, own and operate a Behind-the-Meter/Load Displacement solar PV generation on third-party owned facilities, located on the same property. The facility owner, as the end-user/consumer, will use purchase the electricity generated by the solar system from PS12.

After considering the evidence and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence to Potentia Solar 12 Limited Partnership.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application by Potentia Solar 12 Limited Partnership for an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
