2023 Transmission Revenue Requirement

Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2022-0250

In its January 14, 2016, Decision and Order<sup>1</sup>, the OEB approved a 2016 revenue requirement of \$4,647,201 for Canadian Niagara Power Inc. (CNPI) through a cost of service application. CNPI has not applied for transmission revenue requirements other than foregone revenue and interest disposition since that time.

The OEB is in the process of approving individual transmitters' 2023 revenue requirements and establishing the 2023 Uniform Transmission Rates (UTRs). Could you please confirm by October 14, 2022 that CNPI will not be submitting a 2023 transmission revenue requirement application or seeking any adjustments to the approved revenue requirement of \$4,647,201 for 2023?
