INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Shell Canada Products filed an application on September 29, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

Shell Canada Products' electricity wholesaler licence EW-2017-0276 is set to expire on October 11, 2022. In order for the applicant to perform electricity wholesaling activities in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity wholesaler licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of Shell Canada Products' electricity wholesaler licence EW-2017-0276 is extended on an interim basis until April 1, 2023, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
