Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd. has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2023.

Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2023. If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service customer of Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd. would see the following increase:

Rate Class	Monthly Bill Impact
Residential 750 kWh	\$0.31 per month
General Service less than 50 kW (2,000 kWh)	\$2.11 per month

Other customers, including businesses, may also be affected.

The requested rate increase is set using an OEB-approved formula which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency.

Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd. states its 2021 earnings were in excess of the threshold set by the Ontario Energy Board. The Ontario Energy Board will review Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd.'s request for an increase in the context of its reported over earnings.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Lakeland Power's application. We will determine whether the company has used the applicable models and formulas required by the OEB and whether to approve Lakeland Power's request for a rate adjustment, given its reported over earnings. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals that have registered to participate (called intervenors) in the OEB's hearing. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, rate change will be allowed.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review Lakeland Power's application on the OEB's website now
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing
- You can become an intervenor. As an intervenor, you can ask questions about Lakeland Power's
 application and make arguments on whether the OEB should approve Lakeland Power's request.
 Apply by November 17, 2022 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any
 further notice of the proceeding
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website

The OEB does not intend to consider cost awards for this hearing.
