Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Beaver Power Corporation filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on September 1, 2022, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence renewal.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Beaver Power Corporation generates electricity through hydroelectric power stations to distribute electricity in Canada. The applicant is currently licensed to own and operate two electricity generation facilities in Ontario, namely:

- 1. 4 MW hydroelectric generation facility, located on the Aux Sables River, in the District of Sudbury, Ontario and;
- 2. 7 MW hydroelectric generation facility located on the Serpent River, in the District of Algoma, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Beaver Power Corporation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
