Re: Request for Intervenor Status and Cost Eligibility

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.

2023 Federal Carbon Pricing Program Application

This letter is in response to your letter dated November 15, 2022, filed on behalf of Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME) requesting intervenor status and cost eligibility in the above proceeding. The deadline for applying for intervenor status and cost eligibility was on November 8, 2022.

In its letter, CME stated that its request was delayed because it was not able to complete its internal reviews by the original intervention deadline and that it filed its request as soon as possible. No objection was received from Enbridge Gas Inc.

CME is approved as an intervenor and is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. CME shall accept the record of proceeding as it stands and should consult the OEB's Procedural Order No.1, dated November 14, 2022, for the schedule for the case and other matters.

CME is expected to focus its participation on material issues and avoid duplication. In making its decision on cost awards, the OEB will consider whether CME made reasonable efforts to avoid duplication and focused its participation on material issues. Being eligible to apply for recovery of costs is not a guarantee of recovery of any costs claimed. Cost awards are made by way of OEB order at the end of a hearing.
