Re: EB-2022-0200, EGI 2024 Rebasing - GEC Intervention and Request for Costs Eligibility

1. The Green Energy Coalition (GEC) hereby seeks intervenor status in this matter and requests that it be found eligible for costs.
2. The GEC is comprised of the Greenpeace Canada and Sierra Club of Ontario. GEC's member groups are charitable or non-profit organizations active on environmental and energy policy matters.
