Instead of squeezing many Ontarians, 26% of which are living paycheque to paycheque in 2022, where current inflation is at 6.9%, why not absorb some of these charges as Enbridge's revenue for 12 months ending Sept 30 2022 was over \$40 BILLION? This translates to a nearly 20% increase year over year.
