Harmonized rates for harmonized zones is not ideal for the consuming clients.

Cost of delivery for those further away from original storage makes sense as they are maintaining larger portions of area (equipment and lines etc) [clients in further away areas typically have a lower land/homing cost].

Clients living closer to storage areas shouldn't be penalized for maintaining ADDITIONAL equipment/lines/etc that they do not use,
