Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation

Application for electricity distribution rates beginning May 1, 2023

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 November 25, 2022

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation (Chapleau Public Utilities) filed an incentive ratesetting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 11, 2022, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) seeking approval for changes to the rates that Chapleau Public Utilities charges for electricity distribution, beginning May 1, 2023.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on October 31, 2022. No persons applied for intervenor status.

At this time, the OEB is making provision for the filing of interrogatories, responses to interrogatories and submissions. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- OEB staff shall request any relevant information and documentation from Chapleau Public Utilities that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Chapleau Public Utilities by **December 14, 2022**.
- 2. Chapleau Public Utilities shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories by **January 12, 2023**.
- 3. Any written submissions by OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and served on Chapleau Public Utilities by **January 26, 2023**.
- 4. Any reply submissions by Chapleau Public Utilities shall be filed with the OEB by **February 9, 2023**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is

defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's <u>Rules of Practice and Procedure</u>.

Please quote file number, **EB-2022-0021** for all materials filed and submit them in searchable/unrestricted PDF format with a digital signature through the <u>OEB's online</u> filing portal.
