



The Licensee is exempt from the requirements of section 2.5.3 of the Standard Supply Service Code with respect to the price for small volume/residential consumers, subject to the Licensee offering an equal billing plan as described in its application for exemption from Fixed Reference Price, and meeting all other undertakings and material representations contained in the application and the materials filed in connection with it.
	 2. The Licensee is exempt from the requirements of section 6.5.4 of the Distribution System Code until January 1, 2011 in relation to the following seven load transfer customers located within the Towns of Stayner and Collingwood: (a) 70 Nottawa Sideroad, RR4 Stayner - Con 5 PT E ½ Lot 36 RP; 51R24340 Part 2; (b) 48 Nottawa Sideroad, RR4 Stayner - Con 5 N PT Lot 36 RP; 51R29218 Part 1; (c) 26 Nottawa Sideroad, RR4 Stayner - Con 5 N PT Lot 36; (d) 48A Nottawa Sideroad, RR4 Stayner - Con 5 N PT Lot 36 RP; 51R29218 Part 2; (e) 2380 Fairgrounds Road, Collingwood - Con 5 N PT Lot 36 RP 51 R9993; Parts 1&2; (f) 9257 Highway 26 East, Collingwood - Con 5 PT Lot 37; and (g) Nottawa Sideroad East, Collingwood - Con 5 PT Lot 37 RP 5 1R1 4133; Part 1.
	3. The Licensee is exempt from the requirement to implement time-of-use pricing as of the mandatory date for its RPP customers with eligible time-of-use meters as required under the Standard Supply Service Code for Electricity Distributors. The mandatory time-of-use pricing date exemption expires on December 31, 2011.
	Code exemption conditions 1&3 above are no longer necessary and can be removed.
