I have significant concern about the application for Incentive Rate-setting Mechanism. During a time of high inflation, we are allowing Enbridge to not only start off by significantly increasing the rates of former Union Gas South customers, but also allowing them easy 6, 7, 8% increases year after year.

During unexpected high inflation, I would appreciate the OEB checking to make sure that Enbridge has a justified reason for increasing rates year over year rather than allowing easy increases that have been evident for the past year, and without a clear benefit to that rate increase. Inflation is never the excuse to raise prices when inflation is not properly controlled. And right now, inflation is not within its normally operating parameters.

I didn't read their application. I am not an Enbridge or OEB employee. There are definitely smarter people who can analyze it than myself; but certainly we seen how quickly corporations will use inflation as a justification to raise prices, even when business costs are not.
