**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas, or the Company)
EB-2022-0200 - 2024 Rebasing - Response on Interventions**

On October 31, 2022 Enbridge Gas filed its application and the majority of its supporting evidence for the Company's 2024 Rates Application. In this application Enbridge Gas requests approval of rates for the sale, distribution, transmission, and storage of gas commencing January 1, 2024. Enbridge Gas also applies for approval of an incentive rate-setting mechanism (IRM) for the years from 2025 to 2028. On November 30, 2022 Enbridge Gas filed the balance of its evidence.

The OEB issued its Notice of Hearing on November 14, 2022, setting a deadline of December 2, 2022 for parties to apply to become an intervenor.
