This letter is to advise Entegrus Powerlines Inc. (Entegrus) that the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is placing into abeyance the above-noted application for a service area amendment.

On October 17, 2022, Entegrus filed an application to amend its licensed service area, as described in Schedule 1 of its distribution licence ED-2002-0563, to include the property and industrial customer located in the City of St. Thomas, Ontario. The customer is currently served by Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One). During the application review, the OEB identified a potential compliance issue related to the service arrangement between Entegrus and Hydro One with respect to the subject customer.

The OEB will therefore hold the above-noted application in abeyance until such time as compliance investigation is concluded.
