Re: EB-2022-0024 – Elexicon Energy Inc. ("Elexicon") IRM Application Tariff of Rates and Charges

Pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's December 16, 2022 Interim Rate Order in the above noted matter, please find enclosed Elexicon's comments on some minor issues within the Tariff of Rates and Charges:

1) On page 6 of the Tariff of Rates and Charges for the Whitby Rate Zone, there is a reference to Whitby Hydro within the definition of the Street Lighting Service Classification that should be changed to Elexicon Energy Inc.:

"This classification relates to the supply of power for street lighting installations. Street lighting design and installations shall be in accordance with the requirements of **Whitby Hydro Elexicon Energy Inc.**, Town of Whitby specifications and ESA"

- 2) On page 11 of the Tariff of Rates and Charges for the Veridian Rate Zone, the following charges appear under "Non-Payment of Account", but not under "Other":
  - Reconnection and meter during regulator hour

\$65

• Reconnection at meter –after regular hours

\$185

These charges must be listed under both categories: "Non-Payment of Account" as well as "Other", as Elexicon's reconnection charges are not solely limited to instances of non-payment. This treatment is consistent with the Decision and Order from Veridian Connections Inc.'s 2014 Cost of Service Rate Application (EB-2013-0174), and Elexicon and Veridian's past Incentive Rate Mechanism applications.



- 3) With respect to the Tariff for both Veridian and Whitby rate zones, Elexicon suggests that the bolded wording below be added to all instances of the Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment Account (2023) to make clear that this rate rider only applies to Class B customers:
  - Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment Account (2023) effective until December 31, 2023 Applicable only for Non-RPP Class B Customers
