**RE: Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation's ("OLG")
Caesars Windsor Casino Complex**
Re: Purchases of Electricity on behalf of OLG

We are aware that Caesars Entertainment Windsor Limited ("CEWL") sent a letter dated September 4, 2014 to the OEB requesting confirmation that CEWL is exempted from the requirement of obtaining a Retailer Licence ("CEWL's Letter").

As you know from CEWL's letter, CEWL is the operator of OLG's Caesars Windsor casino complex (the "Casino Complex"). CEWL holds an Electricity Wholesaler Licence, EW-2014-0146, and pursuant to that licence CEWL purchases electricity in the IESO-markets on behalf of OLG for use in the Casino Complex.

We are of the view that OLG does not need to have an Electricity Wholesaler Licence because OLG does not directly participate in the IESO-markets, and the purchases in the IESO-markets for the Casino Complex are being carried out on OLG's behalf by CEWL which is a party that has a Wholesaler Licence. We would appreciate receiving the OEB's confirmation that it agrees that OLG does not need a Wholesaler's Licence in the circumstances described in this letter and in CEWL's letter.
