

Gosfield Wind Project Awarded 20-year Contract

Having secured a 20-year power purchase agreement from the Ontario Power Authority, Brookfield Renewable Power is finalizing the design and permitting, contracting and planning for construction of a 22-turbine wind farm in the area formerly called Gosfield North.
