Re: ALECTRA UTILITIES CORPORATION INCREMENTAL CAPITAL MODULE APPLICATION FOR 2023 ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATES AND CHARGES (EB-2022-0013) – COST CLAIMS

Alectra Utilities Corporation (“Alectra Utilities”) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) on May 16, 2022, under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, seeking approval for Incremental Capital Module funding for its PowerStream and Enersource Rate Zones to be effective January 1, 2023.

The OEB granted the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario, Building Owners and Managers Association (“BOMA”), Coalition of Concerned Manufacturers and Businesses of Canada, Consumers Council of Canada, Distributed Resource Coalition, Environmental Defence Canada Inc., School Energy Coalition, Small Business Utility Alliance, and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

Power Workers’ Union (“PWU”) was also granted intervenor status. In a letter dated, June 8, 2022, PWU indicated that it would not be seeking an award of costs in respect of this proceeding.

On November 17, 2022, the OEB issued its Decision and Order in which it set out the process for eligible intervenors to file their cost claims with the OEB by December 12, 2022, and for Alectra Utilities to file any objections to cost claims by January 11, 2023. This correspondence provides Alectra Utilities’ objection.

BOMA Cost Claim

BOMA has claimed a total of \$2,517.08 in costs, inclusive of HST, in this proceeding. This amount includes 4.0 hours and \$1,491.60 of costs for written submissions. Alectra Utilities notes that the OEB’s WebDrawer does not show any written submissions filed by BOMA and that Alectra Utilities has not

received any written submissions from BOMA. Accordingly, Alectra Utilities proposes that the OEB review BOMA's costs related to written submissions.
