Renfrew Power Generation Inc (RPG Inc.) presently operates two generating plants situated in the Town of Renfrew under license EG 2003 – 0133. RPG Inc. would like to request that Schedule 1 of the Electrical Generators License EG 2003-0133 be amended to include the operation of the Thomas Low Generating Station (TLGS) with the other two stations.


RPG Inc. will be the owner operator of the TLGS situated in the Town of Renfrew constructed beside the existing Lower Plant. TLGS will have a capacity of 4 megawatts from the installation of two (2) two megawatt synchronous generators. RPG Inc. has a contract under the HCI upgrade initiative contract number HCI -0051 with the OPA. The project was financed through a loan from Toronto Dominion Bank.

RPG Inc. request that this amendment application be disposed of without hearing, and hear by provides consent to the same. RPG Inc. submits that in accordance with the requirement of Section 21(4)(b) of the Ontario Energy Board Act 1998 no person will be adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of this amendment application proceeding.
