If ENBRIDGE is planning to zap consumers with another rate increase I am totally against regardless of what ever arguments they may present to the Board. I am looking at our gas rates from Enbridge which have increased 92% from Jan to Nov 2022. That is the total gas charge on my bill has gone from 14.5 Jan 2022 to 27.9 Nov 2022.

Further - using your OEB chart on this site the reported Effective price has gone from 18.05 in Jan 2022 to 36.09 Oct 2022 - a whopping 110% increase.

Additionally the effective price has gone from 17.15 October 2021 to 36.09 October 2022 a increase of 110%. How much more do they require?

I believe our Government run OEB should be firm in absolutely refusing Enbridge any price increase approvals no matter how good they make their request look to you.
