## OVERVIEW

InnPower Corporation (InnPower) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 3, 2022 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) seeking approval for changes to the rates that InnPower charges for electricity distribution beginning January 1, 2023.

The OEB granted the Small Business Utility Alliance (SBUA) and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

On December 8, 2022, the OEB issued its Decision and Rate Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received a cost claim from VECC. SBUA did not file a cost claim. No objection was received from InnPower.

## Findings

The OEB has reviewed VECC's cost claim to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that VECC's cost claim is reasonable and shall be reimbursed by InnPower.

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, InnPower Corporation shall immediately pay the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition \$857.50.
