Comments on Draft Issues List

In OEB Procedural Order No. 1, the Board advised that if parties are unable to reach consensus on a proposed issues list for OEB approval, then parties shall file written submissions on these matters by January 16, 2023. TCPL understands that parties were unable to reach consensus on a proposed issues list.

TCPL participated in the issues list conference held on January 9, 2023 and has reviewed the revised copy of the draft issues list that was filed by OEB staff on January 13, 2023. TCPL does not have comments or suggested modifications to that revised draft issues list at this time. As noted by OEB staff, parties may wish to raise additional matters for inclusion on the issues list after EGI's responses to interrogatories are filed, and TCPL reserves the right to do so.

TCPL Evidence

Pursuant to the direction in Procedural Order 1, any intervenor wishing to file evidence in this proceeding must inform the OEB by January 16, 2023 of its intention to do so, the nature of its proposed evidence, and of its relevance to the issues list.

TCPL reserves the right to file evidence in this proceeding. As TCPL contracts for a significant amount of transportation capacity on the Dawn Parkway System, our primary areas of interest relate to EGI's proposed cost allocation, rate design, and service harmonization proposals that impact ex-franchise services that are outlined in Exhibits 7 and 8 of EGI's application. These issues are included in the draft issues list under Phase 1, Sections G and H, and under Phase 2, Section C. The extent of TCPL's evidence to be filed, if any, may be dependent on the content and extent of interrogatory responses received from EGI. In the event that TCPL submits evidence, it will be presented by the company rather than a third-party expert. TCPL will not seek an award of costs for its participation in this proceeding.
