The Independent Electricity System Operator (the "IESO") filed an application on September 4, 2007 with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") for the Smart Metering Entity ("SME") licence under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.* The Board has assigned file number EB-2007-0750 to this application.

Section 53.7 of the *Electricity Act, 1998* (the "EA") permits the Minister to establish the SME in a number of ways, including designating an entity by regulation. Ontario Regulation 393/07, which was filed July 26, 2007, designated the IESO as the SME.
