Dear Ontario Energy Board,

My wife and I are retirees with limited income. We moved to Guelph from the Greater Toronto Area several years ago for more affordable living. Our income does not increase when inflation rises.

I read and tried to understand the extensive and very detailed explanation for the Enbridge gas price increases. I also understand prices increases are inevitable. However, the large increase to the Union South Guelph rate zone (former customers of Union Gas Limited) is unfair. Especially, when Union North West (former customers of Union Gas Limited) and Union North East (former customers of Union Gas Limited) are receiving large price decreases.

All the rate zones in Guelph (that were formerly Union Gas Limited) should share in the increase more evenly. Regardless of how you explain it, as a consumer, all I see is a significant hike in my rates.

Enbridge Gas is a monopoly. It is not possible to shop around to other natural gas providers when we are dissatisfied with their price increases.

If the gas increases indicated are required. I request that you more evenly spread them between the rate zones that were former customers of Union Gas Limited.
