Natural Gas Rates Have Changed

For **Residential Customers** who purchase their gas supply from **Enbridge Gas Distribution**

Rate 1



The Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") has approved changes to Enbridge Gas Distribution's rates effective **October 1, 2018**. A typical residential homeowner will see an annual decrease on their bill of about \$29.

The decrease is due to the cancellation of the Ontario government's cap and trade program, offset by an increase to the Cost Adjustment, higher natural gas prices in North America and higher transportation costs. The chart on the back provides a breakdown of the annualized changes. The total effect on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

The Gas Supply and Transportation to Enbridge charges are based on North American market prices and established transportation prices. We pass these costs on to customers with no mark-up.

The Customer and Delivery to You charges recover fixed costs for infrastructure and customer service, as well as a regulated rate of return. As of October 1, 2018, costs associated with the cap and trade program have been removed from the Delivery to You charge.

Gas Supply Charge

The Gas Supply Charge has increased from 9.4452 cents per cubic metre ("¢/m³") to 10.0500 ¢/m³. The Gas Supply component of the Cost Adjustment is currently a charge of 0.3813 ¢/m³. This charge, combined with the Gas Supply Charge, results in a new total effective Gas Supply rate of 10.4313 ¢/m³.

Transportation to Enbridge

The Transportation charge has increased by approximately \$4.52 per year for a typical customer due to higher costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario.

Delivery to You

The Delivery charge has increased by approximately \$4.22 per year for a typical customer due to higher delivery related costs.

Due to the cancellation of the cap and trade program, effective October 1, 2018, cap and trade costs will be removed from the Delivery to You charge on your bill. This results in a decrease of about \$80.44 per year for a typical customer.

Enbridge has tracked all costs related to cap and trade. On an interim basis, the OEB has approved a Cap and Trade Clearance charge of 1.4176 ¢/m³ to reflect the difference between the amount customers paid and our actual costs. This results in a charge of about \$1.95 and will be included in the Delivery to You on your October bill. To learn more, visit enbridgegas.com/capandtrade.

Cost Adjustment

The total Cost Adjustment charge is 1.0177 ¢/m³, effective until September 30, 2019. Please see the chart on the reverse for the breakdown by component.

Rate Adjustment

The OEB has also previously approved a Rate Adjustment to reflect the difference between the forecast costs for energy conservation programs from 2015 and the actual costs. For a typical residential customer, this adjustment will be a charge of about \$6.46, which will appear on their October bill.

La Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario (« CEO ») a approuvé des changements aux tarifs facturés par Enbridge Gas Distribution à compter du **1^{er} octobre 2018**. Pour un abonné moyen de type résidentiel, ces changements équivaldront à une diminution d'environ 29 \$ par année.

La diminution découle de l'annulation du programme de plafonnement et d'échange du gouvernement de l'Ontario, compensé par une augmentation des coûts d'ajustement, les prix plus élevés du gaz naturel en Amérique du Nord et les coûts de transport plus élevés. Le tableau au verso indique la variation annualisée des tarifs. Votre facture totale variera en fonction du gaz que vous consommez.

Les frais de fourniture de gaz et de transport vers Enbridge sont calculés en fonction des prix sur le marché nord-américain et des prix fixés pour le transport. Nous passons ces coûts aux abonnés sans aucune majoration.

Les frais d'abonnés et de livraison chez vous permettent de récupérer les coûts fixes d'infrastructure et du service aux abonnés ainsi que ceux du taux de rendement réglementé. Frais de fourniture de gaz

Les frais de fourniture de gaz sont passés de 9,4452 cents le mètre cube (¢/m³) à 10,0500 ¢/m³. Le remboursement d'ajustement liés à l'approvisionnement de gaz s'élèvent actuellement à 0,3813 ¢/m³. Transport vers Enbridge

Transportation to Enbridge

If your transportation service is provided by Enbridge

A 'Transportation to Enbridge' charge will appear in the top Enbridge section of your gas charges.

If Enbridge provides transportation service from Western Canada and the United States to our distribution system in Ontario, the rate effective October 1, 2018 is 4.9407 ¢/m³ and results in an increase of about \$4.52 per year for a typical customer due to higher costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario.

Delivery to You

The Delivery charge has increased by approximately \$4.22 per year for a typical customer due to higher delivery related costs. Due to the cancellation of the cap and trade program, effective October 1, 2018, cap and trade costs will be removed from the Delivery to You charge on your bill. This results in a decrease of about \$80.44 per year for a typical customer.

Enbridge has tracked all costs related to cap and trade. On an interim basis, the OEB has approved a Cap and Trade Clearance charge of 1.4176 ¢/m³ to reflect the difference between the amount customers paid and our actual costs. 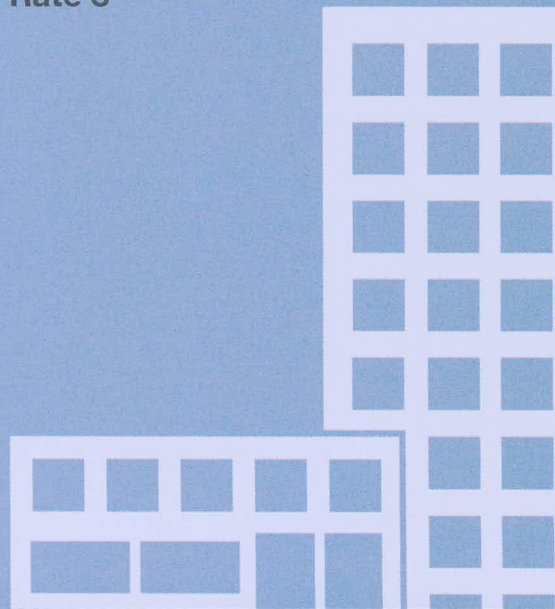

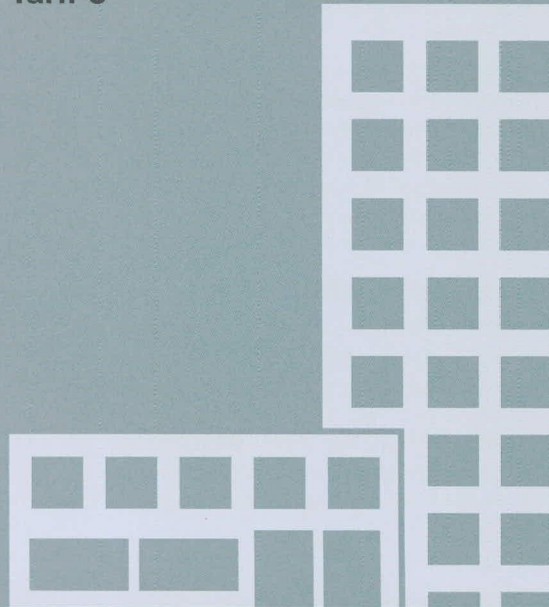
