Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") File No. EB-2022-0028
Argument in Chief and Undertakings - Filing Extension Request

In the OEB's Procedural Order No. 6, dated February 17, 2023, the OEB established a deadline of February 24, 2023 for EEDO to file responses to the undertakings received during the oral hearing in the above noted proceeding. In addition, a deadline of February 27, 2023 was established for EEDO to file its argument in chief.

Since the conclusion of the hearing, EEDO staff have been working to gather historical data and fully respond to the undertakings. Due to the complexity of the undertakings received and the importance to the outcome of this hearing, EEDO requests that the OEB grant an amendment to the procedural timeline and extend the deadline for both items to no later than Friday, March 3, 2023.

Please consider this correspondence a motion to extend EEDO's filing deadline, should the OEB deem that a motion is necessary in this circumstance. We submit that this request is reasonable and will not prejudice the other parties to this proceeding.

EEDO understands that this may impact other deadlines in the hearing and proposes that the Board consider adding the equivalent number of days for each corresponding deadline in order to complete the remaining deliverables.
