**EB-2022-0247 – Kennedy Station Relocation Leave to Construct
Pollution Probe Letter related to Confidentiality Request**

Dear Ms. Marconi:

Pollution Probe noted in its Intervenor Request Letter dated January 26, 2023 that Enbridge indicated a desire for confidential treatment of certain information. Pollution Probe recommended that OEB Staff review the unredacted versions it has access to in order to validate that the redacted information is personal information and not business information. Similarly, on March 10, 2023 Enbridge requested confidential treatment of an Interrogatory Response (OEB Staff IR#10) which relates to the same landowner information along the proposed pipeline routing. Pollution Probe understands that all properties along the proposed pipelines are business properties and that no landowner is an individual requiring confidential treatment. Some of the table responding to OEB Staff IR#10 specifically indicates that the landowner are businesses, including several redacted columns related to properties owned by Metrolinx. It is recommended that this evidence not be provided confidential treatment and that unredacted versions be filed on the public record. As previously noted by the OEB and other parties, the default requirement is to file unredacted information unless there is a specific reason for redacting portions of information in alignment with the OEB Practice Direction on Confidential Filings.
