Re: EB-2022-0178 - Entegrus Powerlines Inc. - Application to Amend Schedule 1 of an Electricity Distributor Licence and Decision on Confidentiality and Procedural Order No. 2

In Procedural Order No. 2 issued April 5, 2023 (PO2), the OEB made certain findings in respect of redacted information described in Entegrus Powerlines' October 17, 2022, letter and found that the information is confidential in accordance with the OEB's Practice Direction and that the type of information is among the categories described in the Practice Direction as "presumptively confidential" and will remain redacted from the public record.

In PO2 the OEB also found that it will allow certain individuals representing Hydro One to access the information provided that the individuals sign the OEB's form of Declaration and Undertaking appended to the Practice Direction, and that the current case is an appropriate case to also accept a Declaration and Undertaking from other Hydro One employees who require access to the information for the purposes of participating in this proceeding pursuant to section 6.1.3 of the Practice Direction.


UNDERTAKING
