**Re: EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership – South Bruce (EPCOR)  
Application for 2023 Rates – Phase 2  
Motion to Extend Timeline  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2022-0184**

Rule 40.03 of the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) *Rules of Practice and Procedures* requires that a notice of motion, including all information under rule 42, be filed and served on all parties to the proceeding to which the motion relates within 20 calendar days of the date of the order or decision that is subject for the motion.

The OEB issued its Decision and Order (Decision) with respect to EPCOR's application for approval of a Customer Volume Variance Account on April 6, 2023.

EPCOR filed a motion in accordance with rule 7 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedures* on April 20, 2023. EPCOR requested an extension of time for the filing of a motion from April 26, 2023 (20 days from Decision issuance) to May 10, 2023.

The OEB has considered EPCOR's request and will grant the requested extension of time. The extension is granted without prejudice to whether the motion meets the threshold test to be heard.

The OEB notes that the procedural schedule set out in the Decision with respect to the draft accounting order process is unchanged.
