# Application for approval of 2023, 2024 and 2025 revenue requirements, expenditures and usage fees

### PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 May 9, 2023

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 29, 2023, under section 25(1) of the *Electricity Act*, 1998, seeking approval of its revenue requirements, expenditures, and usage fees for fiscal years 2023, 2024 and 2025.

In Procedural Order No. 1, issued on May 4, 2023, the OEB established the procedural schedule for this matter, including dates for OEB staff and intervenor submissions on the IESO's proposed issues list and the IESO's response to any such submissions.

#### Request for Extension of Deadline for Submissions on Issues List

On May 4, 2023, the Electricity Distributors Association (EDA), an intervenor in this proceeding, requested that the OEB extend the deadline for party submissions on the issues list until May 15, 2023 given scheduling challenges.

The OEB is extending the deadline for OEB staff and intervenor submissions on the issues list by one day, until May 12, 2023, in response to the EDA's request. The OEB will also extend the deadline for the IESO's response to the OEB staff and intervenor submissions to May 17, 2023. All other procedural dates established through Procedural Order No. 1 will remain unchanged.

#### **Late Intervention Request**

On May 5, 2023, the Power Workers' Union (PWU) filed a late request for intervenor status. The PWU indicated that it was not seeking costs in respect of the proceeding. The OEB understands that the IESO has no objection to the PWU request.

The OEB approves the PWU as an intervenor. The updated list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

#### THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. The dates set out in the "Issues List" section of Procedural Order No. 1 are extended and that section is replaced with the following:

#### **Issues List**

- 1. Any submissions by OEB staff and intervenors on the IESO's draft issues list in Schedule B shall be filed with the OEB and served on all parties by **May** 12, 2023.
- 2. The IESO may respond to the submissions of OEB staff and intervenors and all other parties may respond to the submissions of the other parties. The written submissions shall be filed with the OEB and served on all parties by May 17, 2023.
- 2. All other dates set out in Procedural Order No. 1 remain unchanged.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's <u>Rules of Practice and Procedure</u>.
