The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) is filing revised evidence to correct the allocation of line losses between domestic and export customers used in the calculation of usage fees for 2023 to 2025. The following exhibits have been revised:

The revisions to the above exhibits are needed to address the following two corrections:

- The total demand (not including losses) listed in Tables 2 through 4 of Exhibit C-2-1 was decreased to
 include line losses. The resulting change is immaterial and results in no change in the line losses
 allocated to domestic and export customers.
- In calculating the IESO usage fees, 100% of projected line losses were erroneously allocated to
 domestic customers, which does not reflect the allocation of line losses between domestic and export
 customers set out in Tables 2 through 4 in Exhibit C-2-1. This error has been corrected and the
 recalculated IESO usage fees are set out in the revised evidence.

The revisions to each exhibit noted above have been blacklined for reference.
