**Re: Independent Electricity System Operator 2023, 2024 and 2025 Fees,
Expenditure and Revenue Requirement
CME Letter for Late Intervention to Board File No: EB-2022-0318**

This letter is in response to Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME) letter to the Ontario Energy Board dated May 11, 2023, requesting intervenor status and cost award eligibility in the above-referenced proceeding after the April 28, 2023 deadline set out in the Notice.

In your letter of intervention, you state that the IESO's operations, revenue requirement, and usage fees are of central concern to CME's members. You note that CME intends to participate actively in this proceeding for the purpose of assuring all relevant facts are placed in evidence and making submissions on the issues raised. You also note you intend to seek a cost award in this proceeding.

The IESO does not object to CME's participation. CME is approved as a cost eligible intervenor. Being eligible to apply for recovery of costs is not a guarantee of recovery of
