# NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING FOR AN **ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION** RATE CHANGE

### Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd.

The Ontario Energy Board has received an application on October 26, 2007 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. changes for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2008. The Board has assigned then application for number ER-2007-0835. The Board's decision on this application may lave an effect on all of Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd's customers.

Any change to the rates that Kelora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 1.7% increase in the electricity bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would see an approximate 1.1% increase in the electricity bill.

## How to Participate in the Rate Proceeding

The Board intends to proceed with Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd.'s rate change application by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any objections to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant at the addresses below no later than November 30, 2007. The Board will not be awarding

Anyone who wishes information and material from the applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the applicant on or before December 14, 2007. The applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all parties who asked rogatories no later than December 31, 2007.

Anyone who wishes to make a submission on the application must file that written submission with the Board and deliver it to the applicant by January 14, 2008. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submission(s), the written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all parties who made submissions by January 28, 2008.
