INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Brighton Beach Power L.P. filed an application on May 1, 2023, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for an electricity generation licence renewal.

Brighton Beach Power L.P.'s current licence was issued on May 30, 2003 and remains in force until May 29, 2023. The licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB.

As per section 57 of the OEB Act, no person can participate in the IESO-administered markets unless licensed to do so. Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures and considering that Brighton Beach Power L.P. is currently carrying out activities as an electricity generator in Ontario, the OEB is issuing an interim order to extend the term of the electricity generation licence EG-2002-0525, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of licence EG-2002-0525 is extended to July 15, 2023, or the date of a final determination of the electricity generation licence renewal application, whichever is earlier. All other conditions of licence EG-2002-0525 remain unchanged.
