Dear Mr.Tomek:

Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. Final Monitoring Report for the North Bay (Northshore and Peninsula Roads) Pipeline Project Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2019-0188

On May 7, 2020, the Ontario Energy Board issued its Decision and Order for the above noted proceeding, which included several Conditions of Approval. In accordance with condition 7 (b), Enbridge Gas Inc. filed a Final Monitoring Report dated May 26, 2023. OEB staff reviewed the Final Monitoring Report and requests that Enbridge Gas Inc. provide a written responses to the following questions:

- On page 8, EGI states, "All areas in proximity to watercourses crossings have been fully restored and no further actions are required." Is this EGI's opinion or someone else's opinion? If it is EGI's opinion, please provide a brief summary of the qualifications of the person making the determination. If it is someone else's opinion, please identify them (e.g., Stantec or the North Bay – Mattawa Conservation Authority).
- 2. Regarding the well water sediment problem reported to EGI on August 15, 2020 (second entry in Table 2), please confirm whether the landowner signed an agreement accepting the compensation for well repair or replacement.
- 3. In the second last entry in Table 2, EGI states, "A resident contacted Enbridge Gas raising concern for easements, indicating that their deed shows that they own the road the pipeline is being installed along as part of their property." EGI states that the resolution was that "Enbridge Gas provided the resident with a copy of the franchise agreement with the City of North Bay which showed Enbridge Gas's right

to install pipelines on public highways maintained by the City of North Bay." This resolution does not seem to align with the concern. Please explain how providing a copy of the franchise agreement addresses the concern that the landowner's deed shows the portion of road in question to be private property?
