Bombers GM making the right moves

You've got to give the Winnipeg Blue Bombers credit for one thing: they've breathed new life into the stiff known as the CFL trade deadline.

The CFL's trade deadline always comes and goes without much as a whimper, because nobody's ever eliminated from the playoff race with still four weeks to go.

Enter your 2013 Bombers, who've mastered the trick with two wins in 14 games.

"Generally in an eight-team league where six of them make the playoffs, at the trade deadline most teams are in the mix to some degree," acting GM Kyle Walters said, Monday. "I guess mathematically we still have a chance. But the reality of the situation is making decisions for the future has to be in the thought process."

So Walters swung the deal that sent defensive end Alex Hall, arguably Winnipeg's most valuable player this season, to Saskatchewan and brought O-lineman Patrick Neufeld to Winnipeg.

On the surface, this looks like a win-win: the Riders, with a glut of quality Canadian linemen, might not have been able to keep the 24-year-old Neufeld past December's dispersal draft to stock the expansion Ottawa RedBlacks.

And the Bombers weren't expecting to keep Hall, the CFL's sack leader, past the next four games — he plans to chase his NFL dream as a free agent.

The Riders don't care. They just want Hall to help them get to the Grey Cup, to be played in their own backyard.

"There's two ways I could go," Walters said. "One would be to sit on my hands and wait for the season to play out... or I can take a proactive role and do what I think's best for this organization. And that's the route I've chosen to take." Good on him.

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF KENORA HYDRO ELECTRIC CORPORATION LTD.

Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. has applied to lower its electricity distribution rates.

Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. ("Kenora Hydro") has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to decrease the amount it charges by approximately \$1.43 each month for the typical residential customer beginning on May 1, 2014. Other customers, including businesses, may be affected as well.

The requested rate decrease is tied to inflation (and other factors intended to promote efficiency).

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING
The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Kenora Hydro's request. We will determine whether Kenora Hydro has used the applicable models and formulas as required by the OEB. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide on the appropriate rate changes.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED
You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process. You can:

- review Kenora Hydro's application on the OEB's website now;
- sign up to observe the proceeding by receiving OEB documents related to the hearing;
- at the end of the process, review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

If you wish to become an active participant (called an intervenor) in this proceeding, you must apply for intervenor status to the OEB no later than 10 calendar days after the publication or service date of this notice, or the hearing will go ahead without you, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding. If you do not wish to become an intervenor but wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board members hearing the application, you are invited to file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.

The OEB does not intend to award costs in this proceeding as Kenora Hydro has only made proposals of a mechanistic nature within the OEB's guidelines.

However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This rate hearing will be held under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998 c.15 (Schedule B).
